HELICOPTER FLIGHTS

CANADA

TADOUSSAC - DAY 03

Fly over Tadoussac's village situated in the North Shore tourist region of Québec at the maritime junction of the St. Lawrence River and the Saguenay Fjord. This quite village has been listed as one of the 50 most beautiful bays in the world. But above all, it is an internationally-renowned whale-watching site.

- St Lawrence River - 20 minute flight
- Baie-des-Rochers - 30 minute flight

PERCÉ & BONAVENTURE BAY - DAY 05

Fall in love with Percé as you fly over this charming village. You will have the opportunity to see the Percé Rock, one of the largest arches over water in the world. In addition, Bonaventure Island just off the coast. This iconic island is home to the largest colony of Northern Gannets. If you are lucky, you will catch a glimpse of some of the many seabirds that migrate to the area and several species of marine life.

- Percé Rock, Bonaventure Island and Pointe Saint-Pierre - 20 minute flight
- Grande-Grave - 40 minute flight

GROS MORNE NATIONAL PARK - DAY 06

Surrounded by Soaring fjords, Panoramic beaches and barren cliffs Gros Morne National Park is a UNESCO World Heritage site spanning 1,805km. Fly over the amazing natural landscape of Trout River and Woody Point and witness the barren Tablelands. View Western Brook Pond, a Canadian fjord part of the Long Range Mountains part of the Appalachian Mountains.

- Trout River and Woody Point - 20 minute flight
- Western brook pond - 30 minute flight

LOUISBOURG – DAY 09

Discover endless history and nature as you fly through Louisbourg. Soar over The Fortress of Louisbourg, a one of its kind French town on the rocky shoreline of east Nova Scotia. Venture to the picturesque Mira River Provincial Park, known for its sprawling lake side wooded areas. Fly over one of Canada's Nature preserves, the Gabarus Wilderness Area with over 3,900 hectares of coastal lands along the Atlantic shore of Cape Breton Island.

- The Fortress of Louisbourg, Mira River Provincial Park - 20 minute flight
- Gabarus Wilderness - 30 minute flight

LUNENBURG – DAY 11

Explore the UNESCO World Heritage Site of Old Town Lunenburg known for its unique architecture and distinctive waterfront. Continue on to the picturesque town of Mahone Bay known as the home of The Three Churches and one of Nova Scotia's most well know seaside communities. Discover Peggy's Cove, one of Nova Scotia's most iconic and maybe the most photographed lighthouses in Canada.

- Old Town Lunenburg - 20 minute flight
- Peggy's Cove - 40 minute flight

PORTLAND - DAY 13

Starting right from the heart of the city you'll see most of Portland's renowned parks as well as its gorgeous skyline. On clear days you'll see out to the Cascade Mountains in the east and all the way to the Coast Range in the west. An exhilarating way to get to see Portland. Rise up among the buildings and bridges.

- Johns Bridge, Forest Park, - 20 minute flight

MARTHA'S VINEYARD - DAY 14

Located south of Cape Cod take the opportunity to see Martha's Vineyard and its pristine beaches, picturesque lighthouses and the town of Aquinnah with its breathtaking cliffs. Venture out to the outer islands such as Naushon Island and the south west corner of Cape Cod, Woods Hole.

HAVRE ST PIERRE - DAY 04

The Mingan archipelago is located in front of the city of Havre St-Pierre and offers a great environment for diving. Abundant flora and fauna await the visitor on the beautiful rock formations. You may see Atlantic wolffish, Ocean pout, Nudibranchs and opaque white, orange, and brown specimens of Giant Plumose Anemone. If we are lucky, we might be joined by one of the Grey seals, Harbour seals or Harp seals that inhabit the islands of the archipelago.

- 20 minute dive

GROS MORNE NATIONAL PARK - DAY 06

The Wall in Bonne Bay, near Norris Point in Gros Morne National Park, is the crown jewel of West Coast Newfoundland diving.

- 40 minute dive

LUNENBURG - DAY 11

Lying off the coast of the Lunenburg Harbour you will find the HMCS Saguenay. Previously a destroyer in the Royal Canadian Navy and Canadian Forces, this ship is now an artificial reef home to an abundant of sea life.

- 20 minute dive
